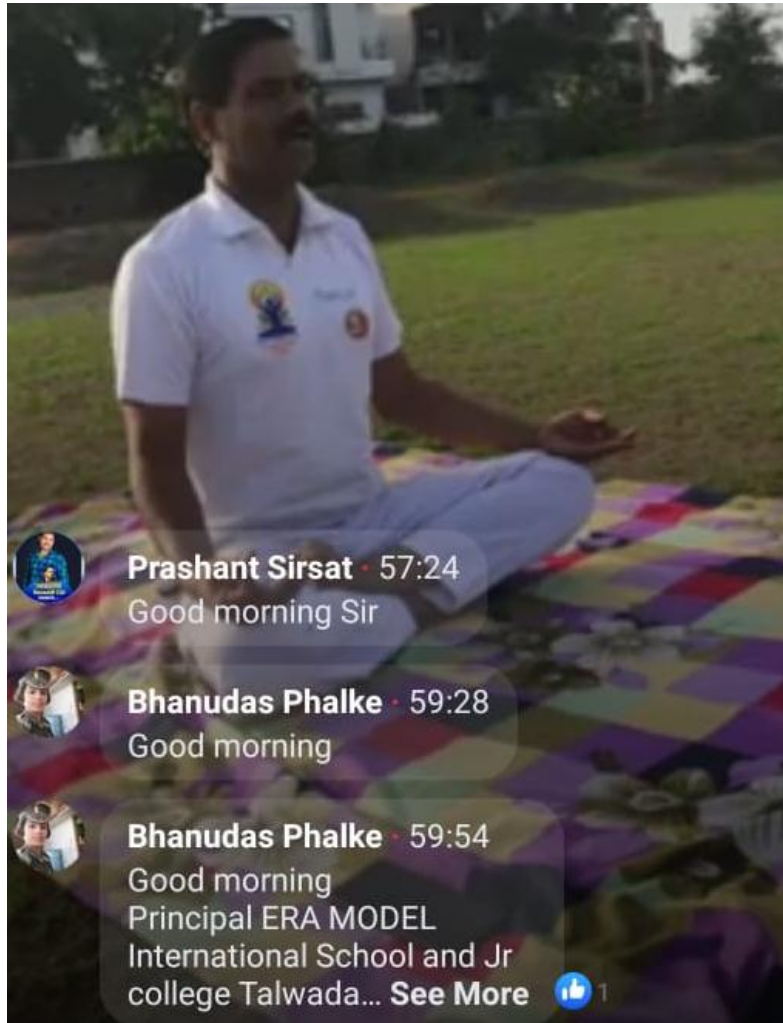

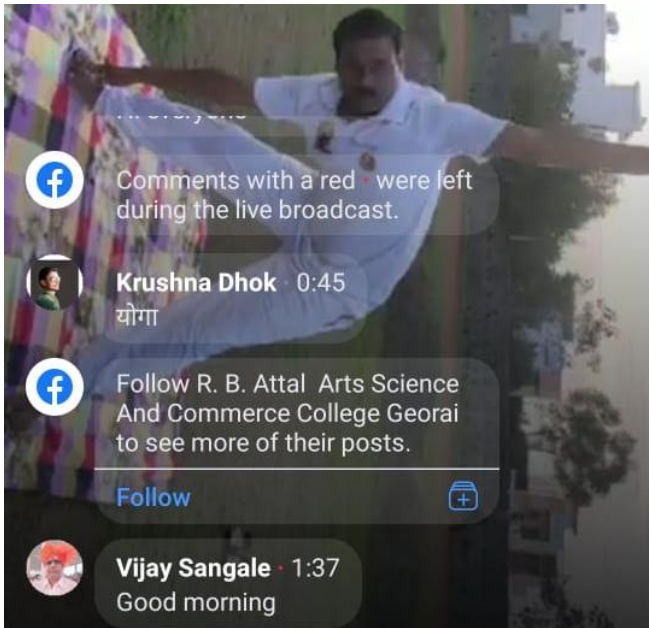
The department of National Cadet Corps organised the following activities in the academic year 2020-21.

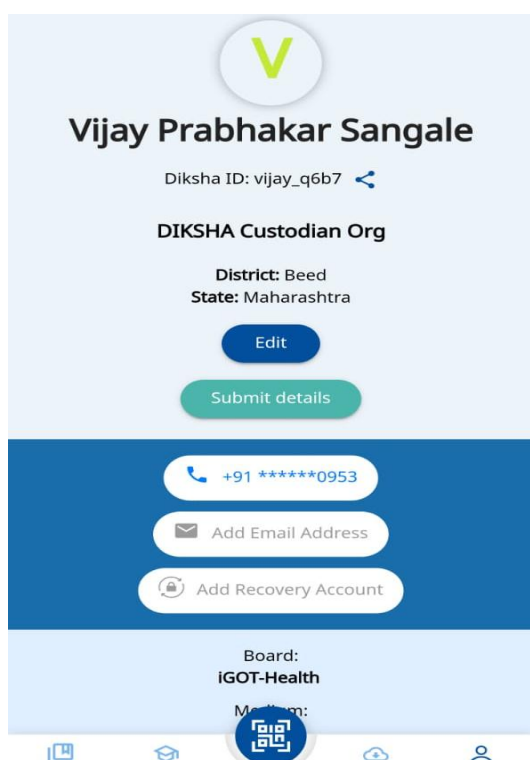

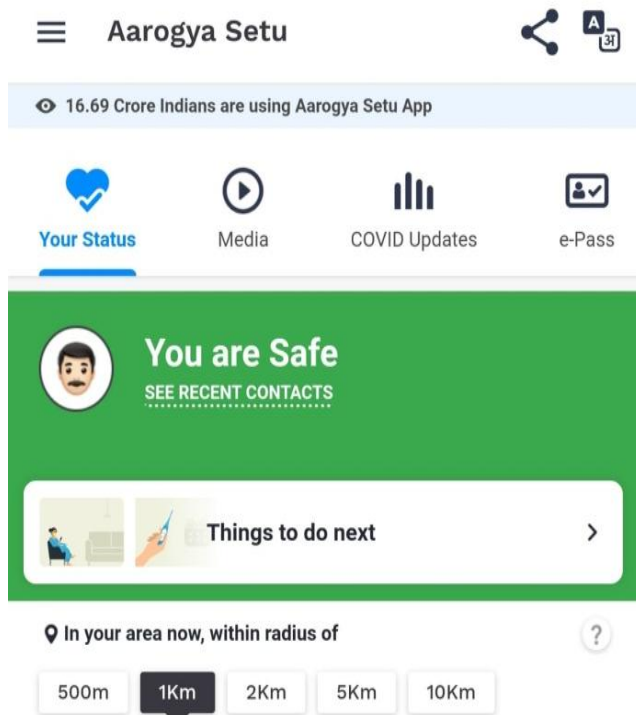

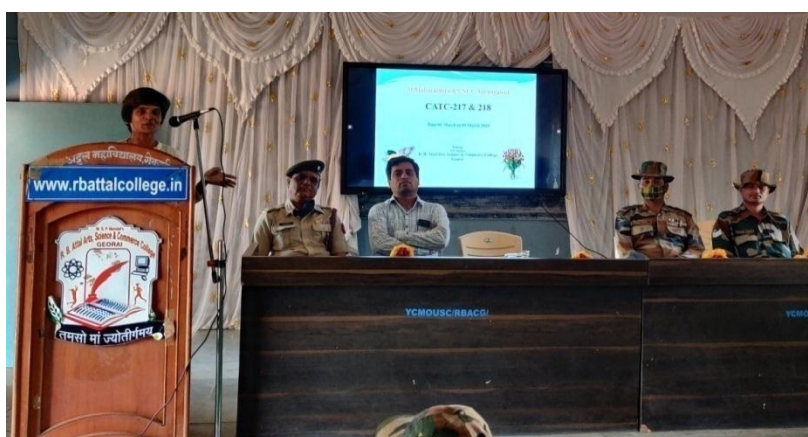
